- Rank 2 from Phase II (Oral) round will be rewarded with Merit Certificate + Silver Medal + Digital Camera
- Rank 3 from Phase II (Oral) round will be rewarded with Merit Certificate + Bronze Medal + Wrist watch
- Rank 4 to 10 from Phase II (Oral) round will be rewarded with Merit Certificate.

All guests are requested to maintain discipline and silence in the auditorium and abide by the moral conduct and rules of our competition. This is a National Final round and it will be tough for students; so please give motivation and encouragement to all participants.

Specific Rules for Geography Olympiad National Finals 2018-2019

1. There are three categories of competition for Geography Olympiad:
 - **SUB JUNIOR** : 2, 3 and 4 class
 - **JUNIOR** : 5, 6 and 7 class
 - **SENIOR** : 8, 9 and 10 class
2. A 1st rank winner at National Finals of Geo-Genius Senior Geography Olympiad is **not eligible** for competing in the same category in future Geography contests conducted by the Geo-Genius (National winner of lower category can only participate in higher category).
3. The National Finals of the Geography Olympiad will be held in **two phases**.
 - Phase I is written.
 - Phase II is a mix of oral and written rounds followed by a **Championship Round**.
4. The contest may include questions with multiple – choice format and without multiple – choice format.
 - Contestants are responsible to bring **their own pen, pencils, erasers and transparent writing pads**.
 - Parents are not allowed in Phase I.
 - No copying of questions or any sort of audio-taping or video-taping are allowed. If caught, contestants will be asked to leave the room and will not be allowed to compete in any more Geo-Genius Olympiad competition for this year and the future.

Phase I (Written):

- Phase I is a written contest with 30 multiple choice questions. All contestants get the same 30 questions in a booklet. The contestants need to complete this phase in **30 minutes**.
- Unclear and illegible writing might be open for misinterpretation. So, contestants are expected to write clearly and legibly.
- Contestants are required to mark the answers from the question paper to the given response sheet.
- All Phase I packets should be returned at the end of the contest. It is the responsibility of the contestant to write the Name, Class, School name and Roll number on the question paper and response sheet.

Based on the score of Phase I (total out of 30), the judges determine a list of top 10 contestants who advance to Phase II. In case of tie between two or more candidates, score of school level Olympiad will be taken into consideration. If tie is still not resolved the scheme outlined below is followed on the order given, to break the ties:

- **Phase I score among 1-10**
- **Phase I score among 11-20**
- **Phase I score among 21-30**

If tie is still not resolved, a tie breaker round will be held.

Phase II (Oral):

1. Phase II contains oral rounds. In each round, each contestant gets a same question. They will write the answer on a sheet of paper in 15 seconds. The paper is collected and given to the judge for verification when the contestant speaks into a microphone.
2. There is no penalty for mispronunciations (or misspellings in the written response) so long as the judge can determine the contestant knows the correct answer.
3. The pronouncer reads the question along with the corresponding multiple choices (if the question is in a multiple choice format) to the contestant. The contestant will provide the answer. In the case of a multiple choice format, the contestant will provide the answer in both the letter form (ex: A) and the text form (The actual text in the choice.) Both the letters and the test should match. If there is no match, the contestant is awarded zero point.
4. The contestant is allowed 15 seconds to provide an answer. The judge may award zero point to any contestant who ignores a request to start giving an answer.
5. The contestant is awarded one point for the correct answer and zero for an incorrect answer. If the answer provided by a contestant is incorrect, and the contestant has reached the limit of two mistakes, he/ she is eliminated.
6. Contestants who have not reached this elimination limit advance to the next round.
If all contestants are eliminated at the same time, they all will continue. The elimination process is used to determine the top three contestants. These three contestants advance to the final championship round.
7. If several contestants are eliminated at the same time, and if there are only two contestants remaining, those two automatically advance to the final championship round. Remaining contestants, however, will continue to determine the third spot for the championship by using single-elimination round.
8. If several contestants are eliminated at the same time, and if there are only one contestant remaining, that contestant advances to the final round. The remaining contestants will continue till only two contestants remain. These two will move on to the final championship round.

Championship Round, Winners and Ranks:

The first, Second and Third place winners are decided based on single elimination rounds in the Championship Phase. All three contestants are administered common questions. This is a single-elimination round. There is a possibility of more than two contestants getting eliminated in one round. If that happens, the contest continues for the second and third position but the other candidate is the champion. The first place winner **shall be ahead by at least one point** to be declared as the champion. If any of these top three positions remains tied after a maximum of about 10 rounds, it will be decide on the basis of **Phase I (written)** marks. **Based on the situation, the coordinators and the judges may reduce or increase the number of rounds allowed for the championship round. Their decisions are final.**
